WHEREAS, Article IV of Ordinance No. 2012-02 (Said Ordinance relating to collection, storage and disposal of garbage, recyclables and bulk items) authorizes the Township to, by Resolution, enact provisions necessary for administration of the Ordinance, including but not limited to fees and costs.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors incurs an expense to collect and then redistribute trash totes and recycle bins.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of West Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1. Resident shall pay the sum of TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) to reinstate service to a trash account that was terminated for non-payment.
- 2. Any Resolutions or Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
