

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF A MILLAGE RATE FOR A FIRE TAX TO BE LEVIED UPON REAL PROPERTY IN SAID TOWNSHIP BEGINNING IN THE YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, West Pennsboro Township recognizes the need to provide adequate fire protection services to protect the life and property of its residents; and

WHEREAS, to accompany this responsibility, the Second Class Township Code also provides for a maximum of three (3) mills of Real Estate Tax dedicated solely to fire protection services as described in Section 3205.4; and


WHEREAS, the Township population has been and will continue to grow and will demand more and better services from the Township Government, which will require ample funding to provide adequate equipment and needed supplies to the emergency providers who serve the residents of this Township; and

WHEREAS, in order to be able to pay for these needed services, it is the intention of the Township to dedicate a funding source;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of West Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania hereby enacts a **0.25** mill Fire (Real Estate) Tax as provided for in Section 3205 of the Second Class Township Code. Said Tax equates to \$25.00 on a property assessed at \$100,000 and may remain in effect for the 2016 Budget Year and thereafter renewed at an annual rate as set by the Board of Supervisors in accordance with applicable law.


