Minutes of Meeting

West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority January 24, 2023

The West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority met on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, 7:30 AM, at the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Building, 2150 Newville Road, Carlisle, Pennsylvania. The following Authority members were present: Chairman William L. Piper, Vice-Chairman John Bixler, and Secretary Jane F. Burke. D. Mark Lehman and James Snyder were absent.

Also present: Solicitor Mark Allshouse, Nancy Adams of GHD, Director of Operations Wayne E. Myers, and Administrative Assistant Myra Barrick.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman William Piper called the meeting to order at 7:31 AM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

With corrections of adding Phil Garland and Justin Doty as Public Participation and revisions of the minutes in the Engineer's Report referencing the force main along Route 641, the Board <u>approved</u> the minutes of the December 20, 2022, meeting of West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority on a **Burke/Bixler motion**.

OLD BUSINESS

Delinquent Accounts Update

Myra Barrick, Administrative Assistant, reviewed the Aging Report of delinquent accounts. Letters were sent to Travis Williams at 8 East Main Street, Ian Fanton at 20 Greason Road, and John Heidler at 61 Greason Road for delinquency of sewer fees. Ian Fanton has paid his amount in full. The other two customers have until February 17, 2023 to pay their balance, or a lien will be filed.

Edward Giemza at 80 Greason Road currently has a delinquent balance of \$10,033.51 with several liens already filed. Ms. Barrick reported we do not have any current contact information for him. The Board instructed Solicitor Allshouse to do a Lien Search on this property.

Ritner Highway- New Warehouses

Myra Barrick, Administrative Assistant, reported Exeter 3419 Ritner LLC / Newell Brands at 3419 Ritner Highway has paid their Quarterly Sewer Rental Fees of \$719.99.

Ms. Barrick also reported Allen Distribution at 3455 Ritner Highway has paid their Connection/Inspection Fee for \$50,606.00 and their Quarterly Sewer Rental Fees of \$360.00.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Update to UV Replacement Project

Nancy Adams reported the opening of bids for the UV Replacement Project were held January 12, 2023. The low bidder was PSI Pumping Solutions for a bid of \$284,980.00. GHD issued the Notice to Award on January 13, 2023, and are waiting return of those documents. On a Bixler / Burke motion, the Board approved issuing the contract to PSI Pumping Solutions, pending Engineer's satisfactory review of contractor's Award Documents.

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS

Wayne Myers, Supervisor of Operations, reviewed his report. The West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority and West Pennsboro Township Board of Supervisors have scheduled a joint meeting on Monday, March 27, 2023 at 9:00 AM for the purpose of discussing water options for a potential development.

Supervisors have approved Andy Thomas to start employment in February, 2023 as a part-time operator at our Wastewater Treatment Facility.

TCH Properties have purchased 2092 Newville Road and have requested sewer billing be put on hold until someone moves in. The Board <u>declined</u> his request.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING AND UPDATING PORTIONS OF RESOLUTION NO. 2003-07 ENTITLED "FIXING AND CHARGING SEWER RATES AND OTHER CHARGES FOR USE OF THE SEWAGE COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM TO BE ACQUIRED, CONSTRUCTED, OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY AND FOR COLLECTING, TRANSPORTING, TREATING AND DISPOSING OF WATES DISCHARGED THERETO, UPON OWNERS OF IMPROVED PROPERTY CONNECTED TO SUCH SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR COLLECTIONS AND FOR FILING OF LIENS; REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF SANITARY SEWAGE AND INDUSTRIAL WASTES INTO SUCH SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM; ADOPTING CERTAIN RULES AND REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT TO CONNECTIONS MADE TO SAID SEWER SYSTEM AND USE OF SAID SEWER SYSTEM; THE PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS"

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01

WHEREAS, in accordance with West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority Rates, Rules and Regulations previously adopted, and the amendments and Resolutions thereto, the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority hereby amends the following portions of Resolution No. 2003-07 as it relates to sewer rates and other charges:

SECTION 2. SEWER RATES AND OTHER CHARGES shall be amended as follows:

A. Domestic Establishments

Each Domestic Establishment - \$840 per annum payable at the rate of \$70 per month billing period.

B. Non-Domestic Establishments

1. Each Owner of an Improved Property on which there is a Non-Domestic Establishment which shall be connected to the Sewer System shall pay sewer rates and other charges, except as hereinafter noted, of \$840 per annum per Equivalent Dwelling Unit, payable at a rate of \$70 per monthly billing period, determined on the basis of applicable Equivalent Dwelling Units, as set forth in the following schedule:

2. Notwithstanding the EDU values set forth in subsection 1 above, the Authority reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to use historical water consumption or wastewater flow data for Non-Domestic Establishments in lieu of

the EDU values set forth in the preceding chart wherever the volume of water or wastewater flow shall be metered by the Authority or otherwise, as follows:

All other portions, provisions and amendments not to the contrary to West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority Resolution 2003-07 shall remain in full force and effect.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING PORTION OF THE SEWER SYSTEMS RATES, RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE WEST PENNSBORO TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY ADOPTED MARCH 17, 2004

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-02

WHEREAS, in accordance with West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority Rates, Rules and Regulations previously adopted, and the amendments thereto, the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority hereby amends the following portions of the Rates, Rules & Regulations:

- Sewer System Rates, Rules and Regulations, Article I, Section 1.1 Definitions, #14 Equivalent Dwelling Unit. This definition should be revised as follows:
 - 14. Equivalent Dwelling Unit (EDU). A unit of measure representing the engineering design flow of domestic and/or industrial wastewater for a nonresidential establishment, equivalent to 250 gallons per day (GPD). Each connection is at least one (1) EDU. A property or building may utilize more than one EDU. The number of EDUs is determined by dividing the average daily water consumption by 250 gallons per day.
- 2. Rate Resolution dated 2/14/2003, table in Section 2.B.2. Table should be revised as follows:

Flow Measurement

User Classification

Up to 250 gallons per day (1)

1 EDU

(2)Each additional 250 gallons per day 1 EDU

or fraction thereof

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED that the above sections of the Sewer Systems Rates, Rules & Regulations of the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority are amended as set forth herein.

All other provisions and amendments not to the contrary of the West Pennsboro Township Municipal Authority Rates, Rules and Regulations shall remain in full force and effect.
